- 20 WHEREAS, the Graduate and Professional Student Association (GPSA) of the University of
- 21 New Mexico is the representative body of the graduate and professional students; and
- 22 WHEREAS, the University of New Mexico (UNM) is the flagship university of one of the most
- 23 diverse states in the United States and carries the responsibility to incorporate the state's
- 24 diversity and reflect the values of inclusion in higher education; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the UNM Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Transition Plan required under
- 26 the ADA is currently obsolete and incomplete¹; and
- 27 WHEREAS, record of design changes that have been made to improve accessibility under
- UNM's ADA Transition Plan have not been monitored; and 28
- 29 WHEREAS, there are buildings and spaces on campus that are explicitly inaccessible to students
- 30 with disabilities; and
- WHEREAS, there are students on this campus who are affected by the lack of accessibility to the 31
- 32 detriment of their educational and overall collegiate experience; and
- 33 WHEREAS, the University lacks a fund with the specific purpose of addressing accessibility
- barriers, and forcing so UNM Departments must to use existing budgets to provide 34
- 35 accommodations or correct accessibility barriers; and
- 36 NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that GPSA supports creating and implementing
- a current ADA T transition Pplan that complies with ADA standards; and 37
