BACKGROUND: Forty (40) POINTS

- Applicant's academic/professional interests are clearly stated. (1 - 10 points)
- Financial need is described. (1 – 20 points)
- Applicant demonstrates a strong effort to pursue other sources of funding for his/her education (1 or 10)

BENEFITS: Twenty (20) POINTS

- Applicant clearly explains how the scholarship will contribute toward completion of degree sought (1 – 20)

COMPOSITION: Twenty (20) POINTS

- Proposal flows logically and writing is clear. (1 – 10) points
- Proof reading and Grammar (1- 10)

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION: Twenty (0 or 20) POINTS

- Letter demonstrates that applicant is within semesters of graduating, is in good academic standing, and supports applicant's statement of financial need.

- TOTAL: ONE HUNDRED (100) POINTS
