Section 3. Council Chair

The Council Chair must be a member of GPSA and shall be elected by Council at the regular April Council meeting in accordance with the GPSA Constitution and Bylaws.

A. Duties, Powers, and Responsibilities

1. The Chair shall:

1. Call and preside over Council meetings.
2. Serve as the official representative of the Council to the public.
3. Serve as an ex officio member on the Executive Board, and Legislative Committees.
4. Administer and oversee the Council budget.
5. Other duties as defined by the GPSA Constitution and Bylaws.

2. The Chair shall not vote in Council, except in the case of a tie.

B. Term

1. The term is one year, beginning at noon of the last day of the spring semester and ending at noon of the last day of the following spring semester.
2. An individual may serve a maximum of two (2) terms as the Council Chair.

C. Payment

1. The Council Chair shall receive financial payment for their services. Such payment shall be set by Council in accordance with University policy **and the minimum compensation set by the United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers of America collective bargaining agreement. Any internal changes to compensation will take effect at the start of the next presidential term.** ~~The payment shall neither be increased nor diminished during the duration of their term.~~

~~Section 2.~~ **Section 4.** Legislative Committees

Legislative Committees shall consist of Council Representatives.

A. Composition

1. The Council Chair shall appoint all chairs and members of the Legislative Committees and shall submit these appointments for approval by Council.
2. Council Representatives may recommend nominations for committee positions for Council consideration.
3. Shall be composed of a minimum of five (5) and not more than twelve (12) Representatives representing a minimum of three (3) RDSAs.

B. Legislative Standing Committees

1. Steering Committee shall make recommendations regarding legislations sent to the Council.

C. Legislative Standing Committee Chairs

1. Duties, Power, and Responsibilities

- a. Chairs shall administer committees according to the GPSA Constitution and Bylaws.
- b. The Steering Committee Chair shall oversee the committee and will have no vote except in the event of a tie.

2. Payment

- a. Legislative Standing Committee Chairs shall receive financial payment for their services.

3. Removal
