Summary of key changes/points:

- Title edit: “Justices” to “Chief Justice”
- Clarifying the position tasked with the responsibility of appointing the Chief Justice – the President.
- Grammar edit: “Spring” to “spring”
- Reconciling the term of the Chief Justice to terminate at the end of the spring semester, not guaranteeing each Chief Justice will be appointed for one calendar year.
- Ensuring Chief Justice is paid fairly, tasking the President with establishing the payment.

Found in GPSA Constitution Article IV, Section 2

Section 2. Chief Justices

A. Term of Office

1. The term of office for the Chief Justice shall be one year. The term shall begin after appointment **by the President** and upon confirmation of the Council, and shall terminate on the last day of the ~~S~~spring semester.
2. The term of office for the Associate Justices shall ~~be for their~~ **appointment until the one year.** The term shall begin after appointment and upon confirmation of the Council and shall terminate on the last day of the spring semester.
3. The President and Council Representatives shall have the authority to recommend Justices. All recommendations must be considered.
4. All Justices must be approved by the Council.
5. No Justice shall serve more than two terms.
