Recognized Departmental Student Association (RDSA) – the primary student association of each program, department, and school as recognized by GPSA.

RDSAs may request Pro-Rated Benefits Funds (PB Funds). PB Funds are allocated based on student enrollment.

PB Funds must be requested by the eighth Friday of the fall and spring semesters respectively.

According to the GPSA Constitution, each degree-granting department, school, program or division is entitled to <u>one voting member on the GPSA Council for every 100 (or</u> <u>portion of 100) students enrolled</u>.

The GPSA Council is the main governing body of the Graduate and Professional Student Association. Representatives from each department meet monthly to address issues facing graduate and professional students across campus.
