Summary of key points:

- Add a deadline to the submission of the submission of referendum items, create a candidate meeting for the general election, and specify where students can vote for the general election.

GPSA Bylaws, Article X. Election Code, Sections 2 & 3 (p.53-55).

Section 2. Referenda

A. All referendum items are submitted to the Elections Committee via the Elections Chair or the GPSA Office. (Constitution VII.A-B.)

- All referendum items must be submitted at least two (2) weeks before the general election.

Section 3. Candidate and Voter Eligibility:

C. The Election Committee will hold a candidate meeting for all candidates at least nine (9) days, but no more than eleven (11) days prior to the general election.
