

Attorney General:

- Issuing advisory opinions concerning the law, legislation, or any other act of GPSA.
- The Attorney General shall be required to publish any amendments made to the GPSA Bylaws within five (5) days following approval by the University Council.
- Providing a current copy of the Constitution and Bylaws.
- Updating and distributing the Constitution for the purpose of engrossing any Amendments as passed by GPSA and approved by the UNM Board of Regents.
- The Attorney General is designated the responsibility to publish current editions of the GPSA Constitution.
- Updating and distributing the Bylaws for the purpose of engrossing any amendments as passed by GPSA and approved by the University Legal Counsel.
- The Attorney General is designated the responsibility to publish current editions of the GPSA Bylaws.
- Provide a paper copy of the governing documents to any student or student group.
- Assisting the President in the execution of their duties.
- Serving as ex-officio, non-voting member of Council.
- Attending Council meetings.
- Serving as the parliamentarian of Council.
- Providing advice and counsel concerning all acts of student government legislation.
- Providing counsel for the government in all suits against that government.
- Holding office hours weekly during which time they will be present in the GPSA office.
- The Attorney General is designated the responsibility to correct any grammatical mistakes within the GPSA Bylaws.
- Stipend is determined annually through the annual budget process or appropriation.
