

## LSC Chair

- The Legislative Steering Committee (LSC) is a standing committee composed of Council Representatives.
- The LSC Chair is appointed by the GPSA Council Chair and committee members must be GPSA Council Members.
- The purpose of the LSC is to review non-appropriative legislative items, such as Resolutions and Amendments to the Constitution or Bylaws, and to make recommendations on those items for Council's consideration.
- Each Committee Chair, in conjunction with the membership of the committee, shall maintain a schedule of meetings for that Council session, to be posted in accordance with TPNR.
- Written Legislative Committee Chair reports shall be given once per semester to Council.
- Legislative Standing Committees must meet at least five (5) academic days prior to each regularly scheduled Council meeting after the August meeting in which they are formed.
- Committee Chairs must submit items for inclusion on the Council agenda to the Council Chair at least five (5) academic days prior to a regular Council meeting.
- Supporting documentation for agenda items and committee reports must be submitted to the Council Chair at least four (4) academic days prior to the Council meeting.
- The amount of payment shall be determined through the annual budget process.
