GPSA Student Organization Funding Overview

Funding Opportunities for Chartered Student Organizations (CSOs)

The UNM Graduate & Professional Student Association (GPSA) allocates funding to support student organizations' events, operations, and initiatives.

Funding Types:

- Annual Budget (once a year Spring for next academic year)
 - Eligibility: Must be a CSO (chartered by SAC), have graduate student representation, and attend the Spring Budget Workshop.
 - Covers: Recurring expenses like meeting food, office supplies, advertising.
 - Example: Spring 2026 applications fund 2026–2027 operations.
- Appropriations (once per semester)
 - Eligibility: CSO (chartered by SAC), no workshop required.
 - Covers: Event expenses (food, decorations, equipment) or travel related to the organization.
 - Note: One request per CSO per semester.
- Pro-Rated Benefits (PB) Funds (automatic for RDSAs)
 - Eligibility: Must be a Recognized Departmental Student Association (RDSA) chartered by SAC.
 - Funding: \$10 per graduate student per semester.
 - **Example:** 100 grad students \rightarrow \$1,000 per semester.
 - **Tip:** Activate your GSA to access these funds *It's your money!*

How to Apply & Get Support

Application Steps:

- Check Eligibility on SAC website: <u>sac.unm.edu</u>
- Review Requirements for your funding type: gpsa.unm.edu/funding
- Submit Forms before the posted deadlines.
- For Annual Budget: Attend the mandatory Spring workshop.

Common Mistakes to Avoid:

- Submitting incomplete or incorrect forms.
- Missing deadlines.
- Requesting ineligible expenses.
