- I. Roll Call – 5:24 p.m. Present: Aidan Dunne, Saheed Oyeniran, William Bieker, Mason Leachman, David Lonergan
- II. Opening Business
  - a. Approval of the Agenda – Motion by Aidan Dunne, Second SO, motion passed
  - b. Approval of previous minutes – Approved motions to amend Aidan and Saheed’s name, motion William Bieker, second Aidan Dunne, motion passed to approve minutes
  - c. Media/Gallery/Public Comment
    - i. President Travis
      - 1. Will be asked on each bill to share edits.
    - ii. Council Chair Griego/LSC Chair Lonergan
      - 1. 40% PB Fund vs. 30% PB Fund and 10% freed, increased allocation, grant discretion
        - a. Options:
          - i. Keep it at 40% -- will have mandatory savings
          - ii. Change to 30% -- no mandatory savings, may or may not roll over, council can allocate to student orgs.

  - a. Bill F 2025-001
    - i. Passed bill unanimously
  - b. Bill F 2025-002
    - i. Question: President Travis:
      - 1. Concerning A4: Should we lump directors and chairs?
      - 2. Concerning payment for president: Payment shall not be increased or diminished during their term. “Internal changes to payment shall take effect at the start of the next term.”
      - 3. Concerning Impeachment: Not a recall election, it would be a special election
    - ii. Motion to adopt all President’s edits: Motion by Aidan Dunne, Second by Saheed Oyeniran, Passed
    - iii. Passed bill unanimously as amended
  - c. Bill F 2025-003
    - i. Question: President Travis:
      - 1. Change last sentence on payment to reflect Bill F 2025-002
      - 2. Motion William Bieker, Second Aidan Dunne, passed
    - ii. Passed bill unanimously as amended
  - d. Bill F 2025-004
    - i. Question: President Travis:
      - 1. Part A should discuss committees, not directors

2. Part B should discuss the directors themselves because they chair the committees
3. In Part A, we do not have a PR committee or Political community, but we need finance, grants and elections committees. “Finance, grants and elections are mandatory committees”
4. Motion failed because Travis had further comments
5. President can create directors as deemed necessary
6. Motion to approve president’s edits – Motion SO, Second Aiden, Motion passed
