    - ii. Bill fails unanimously.
      1. Language consistency (Director vs Chair) – why change the title of Finance Chair? If necessary, then perhaps Associate Director instead of Vice Chair?
      2. No more budget workshop on North Campus?
      3. Cutting out all of Article VIII, Section 1. A. 4. seems reckless with no plan to replace it and no explanation for cutting funding to research.
      4. No more notice given to groups submitting bills?
      5. Lots of grammar and formatting edits needed – too many to try and resolve at full counsel.
      6. The only budgetary changes were removing the mandatory lower limits for various grants and adjusting the upper limits from \$1,000 to \$2,000.
      7. Concerns were raised about the \$10/person funding amount for RDSA's since that is an internal SGAO process. If SGAO changes that funding amount, we would need to do a bylaws revision to comport with their internal change.
